Enclosed is one copy of a memorandum dated August 19, 1964, Chicago, Illinois, captioned "Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas." The memorandum pertains to a Five Dollar Federal Reserve Note, Series 1950 C, Serial Number G58070975D, bearing on the reverse side the handwritten notation "will be murdered Kov 22" and the names "Jackie Kennedy" and "John F Kennedy." Also enclosed are two photographs displaying the front and reverse side of this Federal Reserve Note which were propared by the FBI Laboratory.

The Five Dollar Federal Leserve Note referred to by the FBI Laboratory as (Si4 has been designated as Exhibit D236. The results of the examination conducted by the FBI Laboratory determined the handwriting on Q614 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. A photograph of this handwriting has been added to this file.

It was concluded that Lee Harvey Oswald, K4 and E3 in this case, did not prepare the handwriting on Q614.

Specimen Q614 will be retained in the Laboratory pending a determination as to when it can be properly released.

No further action is being taken in this matter. However, the information concerning this Federal Reserve Note is being furnished to the President's Commission. Enclosures (3) 62-109060
