With respect to the duplicate exhibit numbers listed on page one of rebuttal, it is noted that S numbers 43, 42, 44, 8, and 47 were assigned to exhibits selected from the original inventory and numbers in the "P" series substituted for the original item numbers. D-104 and D-105 were assigned to better copies of D-51 since D-51 was not adequate for document examination. D-207 was assigned to the original exhibit since D-71 was only a photograph of the original exhibit.

The laboratory interposes no objection regarding the description of the exhibits listed on pages two through six of rebuttal except as follows:

Item #226 (page two of rebuttal). It is a notebook and has been deleted from Item 235.

Item #262 (page two of rebuttal). The second envelope is postmarked "LAVIDE, 10/7/68."

Item #0-238 (page three of rebuttal). The correct serial number is "523268."

Item #C-307 (page three of rebuttal). C-307 is specimen Q806.

Item #D-369 (page five of rebuttal). The year "63" does appear on the original exhibit.

Item #D-178 (page five of rebuttal). The quoted wording listed for D-178 on page five does not appear on the original exhibit. It is noted that D-178 refers to a shipment of 620 cartons of rifles.
