Result of examination:

The hand printing appearing on Q607 and Q608 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. Appropriate photographs will be added.

The envelope and letter, Q607 and Q608, do not contain any watermarks or other significant features which would indicate the source of the paper and envelope.

It was not possible to determine whether the writing on the envelope was placed thereon after the police department stamp and the postmark stamp.

It was noted that the word "Airmail" on the envelope, Q607, was written with a different pen than that used to prepare the other hand printing on the face of the envelope.

The submitted evidence is being temporarily retained in the Laboratory.

It was not possible to determine whether the writing on the envelope was placed thereon after the police department stamp and the postmark stamp.

It was noted that the word "Airmail" on the envelope, Q607, was written with a different pen than that used to prepare the other hand printing on the face of the envelope.
