Enclosed for the Bureau are the original and one copy of an anonymous letter and envelope addressed "TO ME. OSWALD, In care of The Dallas Police, Dallas, Texas," postmarked Pasadena, California, Movember 23, 1963, and bearing a forwarding address "Miller Funeral Home, Pt. Worth," together with an incoming stamp of the Dallas Police Department showing receipt by the Dallas Police Department an November 26, 1963.

Enclosed for the Los Angeles Office is one copy of the above-described letter and envelope.

This letter reads as follows:

"JR. OFWALD;

"Since you killed Mr. Kennedy, we will kill you no later than December 25, 1963. In spite the efforts of the police we will kill you, You will die the most herrible death you have ever seen in your life. So until we most again I say good by for now.

The above-mentioned letter was made available to SA ROBERT P. GENERLING on July 23, 1964, by Mr. DECLAN P. PORD, 14057 Brookcrest, Dallas, Texas. Mr. FORD stated that this letter was among correspondence in a box containing correspondence of MARINA and LEE MARVEY OSVALD accumulated while she was residing at the residence of JANES M. MARTIM, her former business manager. Mr. PORD stated that MARINA OSMALD took this box of correspondence with her when she moved from the MARTIN home and that this letter had recently been discovered by MARIKA OSWALD and made available to him for referral to the proper authorities. Mr. PORD stated that MARINA GENALD indicated she did not recall ever seeing this letter before.

Mr. PORD stated that MARINA OSNALD would appreciate having this letter returned to her when it had served its purpose.
