**ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,  
11/22/63, DALLAS, TEXAS  
MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING**

On 6/16/64 Supervisor R. D. Rogge furnished the Laboratory the evidence described below:

**D-230 Three one-dollar bills furnished to the Houston Office by Reverend Elton L. Stephenson, Chaplain, Methodist Hospital, Houston, Texas**

One of the bills bears hand printing on the reverse side in the wording "Help! Kennedy will be shot Nov. 22, 1963, warn him please." All three bills have mustaches drawn on Washington's picture. One of the bills has a swastika drawn on Washington's forehead.

The hand printing on D-230 was compared with the material in the Anonymous Letter File but no identification was effected. A photograph of the hand printing will be added to this file.

The submitted evidence is retained. A photograph of D-230 is attached.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That this memorandum be forwarded to Supervisor Rogge for appropriate action. Ten photographs of D-230 are being furnished to Supervisor Rogge separately.
