- K75** Three sheets of paper bearing known handwriting and hand printing of WALTER R. NEWELL
- K76** Three sheets of paper bearing known handwriting and hand printing of GEORGE W. ALLMAN

Result of examination:

It was concluded that Q584 was not prepared by GEORGE W. ALLMAN, K76.

Due to the presence of certain writing characteristics on Q584 which could not be accounted for on the basis of the available known writings of WALTER R. NEWELL, K75, no conclusion could be reached whether he did or did not prepare Q584. If a further examination is requested, then undictated known handwriting and hand printing of NEWELL should be obtained and submitted.

Q584, K75 and K76 are retained.
