ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,

NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO, SIXTY THREE, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION CONCERNING.

BUREAU IN RECEIPT OF LETTER FROM BUREAU OF PRISONS DATED JUNE TEN, LAST, ENCLOSING ANONYMOUS TYPEWRITTEN LETTER AND HANDPRINTED ENVELOPE TO ATTORNEY GENERAL ALLEGING ONE ANDREWS INCARCERATED AT U. S. PENITENTIARY, LEAVENWORTH, HAD KNOWLEDGE OF ASSASSINATION THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO OCCURRENCE. HE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE TOLD QUOTE SEVERAL MEN END QUOTE, PRESUMABLY AT PENITENTIARY THE QUOTE EXACT PLACE, HOW, BY WHOM, AND ALL OTHER THINGS... END QUOTE. WRITER ALLEGES ANDREWS IS NOW SPEAKING OF DEATH OF QUOTE MR. JOHNSON END QUOTE.

BUREAU OF PRISONS LETTER INDICATES BILLY GEORGE ANDREWS REGISTRY NO. SEVEN NINE ONE SEVEN FIVE DASH L ONLY ANDREWS NOW AT PENITENTIARY SERVING SENTENCE FOR DYER ACT VIOLATION. BILLY ANDREWS REPORTEDLY FROM TEXAS AND IS CHARACTERIZED AS OPENLY BITTER TOWARD STATE AND FEDERAL AUTHORITIES AND SOCIETY IN
