## MOEGROUAD:

The Commission, by letter 4/20/64, requested photographic copies of Check's records on a property she eynod on Gasten Street in Ballas for 1953 through 1961 as well as espice of all records for all of her properties (7) for 1963.

Mrs. Cheek, a wealthy women, know Jack Ruby is view of their sutual interest in might clubs. Check's mistor, Enriced Roberts, was landlady at Lee Harvey Garald's Backley Street residence at the time of the mesassimation. Roberts did not take an active part in the management and has denied knowing Cavald or Ruby. This matter has been thoroughly investigated and second-order established between Cavald and Ruby.

We interviewed an employee of Check who idvised she comed a property at \$213 Gesten, Ballan, where two Cubans were reported to have been residing in 1958 and 1959 (when Cavald was in USEC). Efforts to identify these Cubans have been successful. The above facts have been furnished previously to the Countimion. BECEI
