Q618 Western Union Sending Blank bearing hand printed name "Lee H. Oswald," dated 1964, and handwritten message beginning "Hi Lee"

Result of examination:

The handwriting on Q618 was found to be "Hi Lee how are you" and is signed with a name. The first part of the name is "Richard" and the last part of the name is too highly distorted to determine its correct spelling. It could be the name "Gipp" or "Jipp."

Specimen Q618 is retained.
