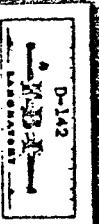

If the parents or guardian wish to avoid disclosure of the facility of any time, they must deliver a certificate of baptism or of naming to the registrar or registration registrar having the custody of the register in which the birth was registered. This certificate must be in the prescribed form which can be obtained on application to any registrar.
