Your suggestion to advise Dallas District Attorney Henry Wado of the findings of our Laboratory does not appear to have any merit and will not be acted upon.

As you are well aware, Wado has created an unusual amount of trouble for this Bureau by his unwarranted and impulsive press releases, his lackadaisical manner in handling his own office, which has resulted in the similar handling of evidence and further, has made statements before the President's Commission concerning the Bureau's informant program which were unfounded.

We are under no obligation to advise the Dallas District Attorney's Office of the results of this matter and Wado is fully aware that our investigative results are furnished to the Commission.

The other observations made by you in retel are being handled separately.
