ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY  
REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION

SA Lyndal L. Shaneyfelt while at the President's Commission today was furnished by Mr. Norman Redlick a copy of a letter to the Chief Justice from Mel Stuart, Executive Vice President of the Mel Productions, Inc., and a 16 mm motion picture film that had been furnished to the Commission with the letter. Mr. Redlick advised that he had dictated a letter requesting Laboratory examination of the film.

The film is to be examined for anything of value since it purports to depict a portion of the actual assassination made by some amateur photographer. The film will be examined and at such time as the letter of request is received from the Commission and the examination completed, they will be furnished the results.
