Rearlets 1/29/64 and 2/14/64 and Laboratory reports
2/4/64 and 2/26/64 regarding the motion picture cameras of
Orville Nix and Mrs. Maria Muchmore. You have advised that both
of these individuals desire their cameras be returned after
Laboratory examination is completed.

Examination of the cameras by the Laboratory has been
completed; however, The President's Commission investigating the
assassination is presently making a detailed study of the motion
picture films of the assassination and the cameras used in making
these films. This study has not been completed and the Commission
is most anxious to retain these cameras until the study is
completed. Attorneys for the Commission have expressed sincere
appreciation for the co-operation thus far extended by Mr. Nix
and Mrs. Muchmore and will be most appreciative if these cameras
can be retained temporarily.

The above information is being furnished to you for your
guidance in the event you receive an inquiry from either Mr. Nix
or Mrs. Muchmore regarding the return of their camera, or you may
wish to express to them the Commission's feelings so that they
will have a better understanding of the need for retaining the
cameras. For your confidential information, the Commission has
advised they will subpoena the cameras if necessary. If you
encounter any difficulty regarding the return of the cameras,
you should advise the Bureau.
