ASERNATHY on 12/1/63 with an expressed desire that the film be returned to him immediately. In view of this, a copy of this film has been made by the Dallas Office through the Jamison Film Company, Dallas. Mr. MIX's film was returned to him on 12/4/63. MIX was standing near the northwest corner of the intersection of Main and Houston Streets. The film depicts the Presidential motorcade making the turn on Houston and approaching the Elm Street intersection to the north. HIX then moved west on Main Street, and the film picks up the motorcade subsequent to the firing of the first two shots. It is believed the film depicts the third shot hitting the President and the sequence of events inmediately after, including Mrs. JACQUELINE KENNEDY reaching out over the back trunk lid to assist a Secret Service Agent who is running to her aid.
