WITH IT? END QUOTE.

ASCERTAIN FULL AND COMPLETE ANSWERS TO THESE QUESTIONS BY  
INTERVIEWING POLICE OFFICERS WHO MADE THE SEARCH OF THE PARKER  
RESIDENCE, MRS. RUTH PARKER, ROBERT OSWALD, MARINA OSWALD AND  
ANYONE ELSE WHO CAN FURNISH INFORMATION ON THESE POINTS. HANDDEL  
IMMEDIATELY AND SUBMIT RESULTS IN LETTERHEAD MEMORANDUM SUITABLE  
FOR DISSEMINATION TO THE COMMISSION.
