ReBuairtel 8-12-63, and report of SA HARVEY E. WILKINSON 9-10-63, at WFO.

On 9-11-63, [REDACTED] of the above committee advised SA WILKINSON that he and the Committee attorney had contacted Mr. YEAGLEY and Mr. LENVIN at the Justice Department about a week ago and had straightened this matter out; and, for this reason, the amount of donations made by Mr. JOSE BOSCH wasn't necessary to disclose.

On 9-11-63, SA WILKINSON attempted to contact Mr. LENVIN, Internal Security Division, Justice Department; but, in his absence, SA WILKINSON was ushered into Mr. YEAGLEY's office.

Mr. J. WALTER YEAGLEY, Assistant Attorney General, Internal Security Division, Justice Department, advised SA WILKINSON that [REDACTED] Executive Secretary of above Committee, together with the Committee Attorney, a Mr. WALSH, both came to the Justice Department about a week ago as an outgrowth of being contacted by Agent Wilkinson of the FBI. They discussed the Committee with Mr. YEAGLEY and his assistant, Mr. LENVIN, and, as a result, agreed to write a letter to Justice outlining the Committee's position.
