IESLIE HOLLANDSWORTH talked to a relaiive, BUSTER D. MITGHELU, in Charleston, West Virginia during November, 1963. Conversation dealt pith integration problems in the South. HOLLANDSWORTI denies maling statement: "You are going to hear something soon that is really going to shock the country." HOLLANDSWORTH has no information concerning assassination of President KENNEDY, IEE HARVEY CSMALD, or JACK RUBY.

IESLIE HOLLANDSNORTH furnished the following information:

His permanent mailing address is $933 \frac{1}{2}$ Elden Avenue, Los Angeles. His temporary address is 71 Parsons Road, Room \#29, U.S. Naval Ordnance Test Station (NORS), China Lake, California. He is currently employed as a cook at the Commissioned Officers' Mess, at NOTS.

BUSTER D. MITCHELL, Charleston, West Virginia, is a relative of HOLLANDSWORTH. They had a conversation in a bar during November, 1963, in Charieston. Their conversation dealt with integration and the attendant problems in the Southern States. HOLNANDSWORTH recalls that during the conversation, he said that "There would be hell to pay" in the South before integration was completed. He also referred to the possibility of more race riots, such as had occurred in the past.

HOLLANDSWORTH denied that he made the statement: "You are going to hear something soon that is really going to shock the country." HOLLANDSNORTH denied that he later wrote a letter to MITCHELL, telling him not to repeat the statement. He said that MITCHELL, after the assassination of President KENNEDY, had a conversation with a Deputy U.S. Marshal, who was a cousin of his, and apparentiy MITCHELL told the Marshal that HoLLaNDSWORTH had made a statement about what would happen in the future, and in this way, it was repeated to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

HOITANDSWORTH advised that he did not lnow JACK RUBY or IEE HARVEY OSWALD, and that he has no information concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY.

HOL工ANDSWORTH stated that IIITCHELL is a known prevaricator and "glory hunter," and that he does not take anything that MLTCHELI says seriousiy.
