Attached are some telegrams from various individuals who make bigoted accusations, unreasonable statements or send messages indicating they may be aberrants. Some of the wires deserve no reply such as one which states: "What were you doing today playing golf or looking for communists." Typical of these indicating mental deficiencies is one reading: "If he was doing his job the President wouldnt be dead today." Another reads: "Why in Texas? Why was President Kennedy killed in Texas Johnsons home state?" Another: "Story of President Kennedy's death is fake." Another states: "As a citizen I request a thorough investigation of the possibility of subversive activity on the part of Lyndon B. Johnson with regards to the assissination recently occurred."

It is not believed these wires deserve any reply whatsoever and no time is being wasted in searching Bureau files for information concerning the identity of the senders.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the attached wires not be acknowledged.
