Your letter of November 22nd, with enclosure, has been received.

I would like to point out that the protection of the President and his immediate family is the responsibility of the Secret Service of the United States Treasury Department, and Secret Service Agents were with the President at the time he was assassinated. As you are probably aware by now, the only law enforcement officer who lost his life was Mr. J. D. Tippit of the Dallas Police Department. In view of this, you may want to contact representatives of that department concerning any donation you may want to give to Mrs. Tippit.
