Department Attorney John Cassidy of the Criminal Division has received a telephone call late this afternoon (11/22/63) from Department Attorney A. Frank Grimsley, Jr., who is stationed in Atlanta, Georgia. Grimsley advised that shortly after word was received in Atlanta concerning the shooting of the President, his secretary received an anonymous call to the effect that "Tonight we will get you too." Grimsley advises that the phone on which this call was received is listed in the telephone directory to the U. S. Department of Justice. Grimsley advised that he had notified our Atlanta Office.

Cassidy immediately advised Assistant Attorney General Herbert J. Miller, Jr. of the above with the observation that possibly this anonymous call might be a threat to the Attorney General.

The Atlanta Office has been instructed to immediately submit full details of the foregoing and advise local authorities. *Atlanta advised they had nothing on this.*
