On the evening of 11-22-63, upon request of the Director's Office, C. H. Stanley of my office talked with Mr. Stephen Banker who had appeared at the Director's Office.

Mr. Banker identified himself as being with CBS and had indicated that he desired information concerning the FBI's activities in connection with the assassination of the President. Mr. Banker asked such questions as how many men we had working on the case and whether we had been in touch with our Dallas Office concerning the activities in connection with this matter. It was diplomatically explained to Mr. Banker that the Bureau would be unable to furnish any information to him.

Mr. Banker reluctantly indicated that he was so advising his office. Mr. Banker thereafter left the Director's Office.
