SUBJECT: DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNIST
PARTY LEAFLETS
NEW YORK CITY
RE DEATH OF THE PRESIDENT.

Jay Sourwine called at 12:30 today and advised that their committee had just received word that the Communist Party is making a "massive effort" to distribute a pamphlet alleging that the President's death was caused by "extreme right wing elements." The pamphlet also points out that Director Hoover of the FBI must also share some of the responsibility. According to Sourwine, most of these pamphlets were being passed out on subway platforms in the New York City area.
