SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

This evening [redacted] San Francisco, California, telephonically contacted Bureau Headquarters and advised he and [redacted] had gone to San Francisco Police Department at 1:30 A. M. November 22, 1963, to furnish information relative to the assassination of President Kennedy, but instead of being allowed to furnish the information, they were apprehended and held in jail until the afternoon of November 22, 1963.

When questioned closely regarding this matter, [redacted] advised [redacted] had furnished information about a narcotics ring operating in San Francisco, and he had furnished information regarding the accuracy of rifles with telescopic sights. [redacted] admitted that he did not in fact know Oswald or Ruby or have any information whatsoever concerning the rifle used by Oswald or the assassination of President Kennedy. He admitted that he only furnished information that a rifle with a telescope can be fired at great distances with accuracy.
