ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT. JOHN F. KENNEDY

CHIEF OF U. S. IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE

DEL RIO, TEXAS, ADVISED FOUR ZERO SEVEN PM, HE RECEIVED COMMUNICATION FROM IMMIGRATION SERVICE CHIEF, CIUDAD ACUNA, MEXICO, THAT MEXICO CITY INSTRUCTED BORDER BE CLOSED AND NO ONE PERMITTED TO LEAVE OR ENTER MEXICO. IN ADDITION, DEL RIO IMMIGRATION CHIEF RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL AT DEL RIO, FROM NUMBER SEVEN SEVEN FIVE DASH TWO EIGHT THREE FOUR, SHORTLY AFTER RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT OF ASSASSINATION, FROM UNIDENTIFIED MALE STATING CAULING FROM FT. WORTH, TEXAS, INQUIRING IF BORDER WAS CLOSED AND COMMENTED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO DRIVE FOUR HUNDRED MILES FOR NOTHING. IMMIGRATION CHIEF HAD NO FURTHER INFO AS TO IDENTITY OF CALLER NOR DID HE KNOW WHETHER CALLER WAS LEGITIMATE. ABOVE FURNISHED FOR INFORMATION.
