He talked to Duty Supervisor Carl W. Spillers of the Special Investigative Division. Mr. White stated that he did not want to be nosey but would like to have some information as to why the Dallas, Texas, Police Department paraded suspect Oswald through a line of people in order to move him from one jail to another. He stated that in his opinion this was foolish and the same could have been accomplished by backing a van up to a door and escorting Oswald into the van, which would have prevented the killing of Oswald. Mr. White advised that he had no information to offer but after watching television most of the day he could not resist registering his feelings concerning the manner in which the Dallas Police Department.
