At 10:20 p.m. on 11/24/63 the New York Office telephoned to advise the Duty Officer at the Soviet Mission to the United Nations received a call from an unknown male who said "If Mikoyan attends President Kennedy's funeral, he will be killed. Keep him the hell away from there."

This information was telephoned to Edgar N. Powers, Bureau of Intelligence and Research, State Department and W. C. Pine at Secret Service at 11 p.m. by Special Agent E. T. Turner. *also given to Police*
