Dear Mr. Hoover:

I am a citizen of the United States. I am not an attorney nor an accountant, and my bank balance would do credit to a Hungarian widow. I am a person of no local, state, or national importance.

I am angry, however. The fact that a President of the U. S. was so easily assassinated seems to me to point up the fact of inadequate secret service or F. B. I. protection. In a nation of some 190,000,000 people it would seem natural to find some paranoiacs, some cranks, and some nuts, but for one of them to be able to shoot down our youngest President —with a scope rifle seems to me incredible. I think you need some thousand helpers.
