I understand that your bureu has been charged with the duty of investigating the circumstances of the death of President Kennedy. There is a most fantastic possibility which I hope has received your attention, namely, the possibility that the assassin had been 'brain-washed' by a person or persons yet to be discovered.

Presumably you are familiar with the plot of a recent movie, "The Manchurian Candidate," in which a person was brain-washed by other persons for the express purpose of assassinating the President of the U. S. This is the fantastic possibility I have in mind.

Of course I don't know anything about brain-washing, nor do I have any way of knowing anything important about a young man who has been arrested and charged with having committed the crime, so I can't do anything more than suggest that this is one of the countless details that ought to be accorded the most strict attention.
