TWO SIX BECKLY DRIVE, DALLAS, OWNER AND OPERATOR OF ROOM-
ING HOUSE AT THAT ADDRESS, REVIEWED HER REGISTER FOR GUESTS
ON NOV TWENTYNINE AND REPORTED THE ONLY PERSON WHO HAD LEFT
HER ROOMING HOUSE IN THE PAST THIRTY DAYS WAS DONALD GREEN.
SHE SAID GREEN WAS EMPLOYED DURING THE DAY AND ATTENDS SMU
AT NIGHT AND AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT, THERE
WERE NEWSPAPER REPORTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS IN THE RESIDENCE
CONTINUOUSLY DURING THE DAY AND NIGHT, AND GREEN TOLD MRS.
JOHNSON THAT HE WAS UNABLE TO STUDY AT NIGHT, AFTER RETURNING A
FROM SCHOOL, AND HE WAS MOVING TO HIS AUNT-S RESIDENCE.
