ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

RE BUTEL, NOVEMBER TWENTY THREE INSTANT.

RALPH V. WALLINGTON, SEVENTY, OF ROSEBURG, OREGON, ADVISED HE WAS IN JACKSON, WYOMING, SEPTEMBER TWENTY FIVE LAST WHERE HE MET AND SHOOK HANDS WITH PRESIDENT KENNEDY. HE SAID LATER WHILE TALKING TO AN EMPLOYEE OF CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, THIS PERSON WHOSE NAME HE DID NOT KNOW, SPOKE IN A DEROGATORY MANNER CONCERNING THE PRESIDENT. WALLINGTON SAID THAT HE REPORTED THIS INCIDENT AND THIS MAN TO A CLERK BY THE NAME OF CLARK IN THE JACKSON POST OFFICE. WALLINGTON THOUGHT THIS <sup>*Jack in Wyo.*</sup> MAN MIGHT HAVE SOMETHING TO DO WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT.

SPECIAL AGENT ROBERT H. SCHMER, SECRET SERVICE, PORTLAND, ADVISED OF ABOVE INFORMATION. DISSEMINATION MEMO FOLLOWS.
