INFORMATION CONCERNING

On November 25, 1963, [George J. Maki, 1417 Pacific Avenue, Santa Barbara, California] telephonically advised the FBI as follows:

He is employed at the [Santa Barbara Research Center] and works as an engineer under the supervision of [H. K. Coulter].

[Coulter] on November 25, 1963, expressed to [Maki] a deep hatred of President Kennedy and made the statement that this hatred was "absolute". [Coulter] further stated it was unfortunate President Kennedy was killed and not allowed to serve out his full term since all his death did was "make a martyr of the s.o.b.".
