At 2:04 p.m. this date, an unidentified Western Union operator, Cable Section, telephonically contacted the NYO and advised that one MANUEL ULLOA, phone number YU 8-9509, had sent a message, this date, to one CELSO FATOR ORTIZ de ZEVALLOS, 298 Lima, Peru, which read as follows:

"So far it has been announced that Erhard and De Gaulle will attend funeral - still believe move suggested yesterday would be most opportune".

NY Telephone Company, NYC, NY, advised that phone number YU 8-9509 is a non-listed number registered to MANUEL ULLOA, 11 East 90th Street, NYC, third floor front. Phone had been moved from previous NYC address - 929 Park Avenue, Apartment 7B, on 11/12/63. Telephone Company advised that this phone number is also connected to an answering service at 241 East 76th Street, NYC.

NYO indices negative re recipient ORTIZ de ZEVALLOS. NYO closed file 105-49850 captioned, "MARIO HERNANDEZ ULLOA; IS - CUBA", reflects that on 5/16/61, [redacted] furnished the then current membership mailing list for RAMAL BD of the July 26th Movement of NYC. This list contained the

-NYO unable to determine if MANUEL ULLOA referred to in NY file 105-49850 is identical with sender of Western Union message, due to insufficient information available.

NYO will conduct further inquiries re sender of Western Union message, MANUEL ULLOA, in an effort to determine the basis and significance of this message.
