This is to confirm my call to Supervisor LUDWIG W. R. OBERNDORF, WFO, 4:15 P.M., 11/25/63.

At 4:12 P.M., 11/25/63 JOHN SHAND, WFVR, TV, RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, telephonically advised that he had just received a call from Mr. STEWART PHILLIPS (phonetic). SHAND said he knows PHILLIPS personally and that PHILLIPS is no crackpot. PHILLIPS had been viewing the funeral proceedings of the late President KENNEDY and had noticed that two men had entered the North Portico of the White House and had left two boxes in the North Portico and then departed. The boxes were still visible on television. PHILLIPS was concerned that the boxes might be explosives.

Supervisor OBERNDORF stated that he would immediately make proper notifications.
