KENNEDY WOULD BE SHOT. [REDACTED] (S) ADVISED CIA THAT HE WAS NOT A
CRACKPOT AND THAT HE CANNOT REMEMBER SPECIFICALLY WHERE OR FROM
WHOM HE RECEIVED THIS INFORMATION . HE STATED THAT HE WOULD
ENDEAVOR TO RECALL THESE FACTS AND IF HE DID, HE WOULD PROMPTLY
FURNISH THEM TO CIA.
