On 11/23/63 ROBERT CLAUDE BOWER, 301 N. DeLeon Street, Victoria, Texas, furnished the following information.

BORN IN DALLAS, TEXAS, PHONE NO. 6-1-32

BOWER advised that he was in the Levi Beer Tavern in San Antonio, Texas, about 10:00 PM on the evening of 11/22/63 at which time he was drinking beer with a Mexican male; and the subject of the President's assassination was brought up. BOWER advised that the individual whom he was talking to stated that he knew who assassinated the President, and he, BOWER, asked him who did it and he stated that the Mexican male would not give him any name. BOWER advised that he met this man at the bar and that they drank five or six beers a piece and were talking to one another only. He stated that the Mexican male appeared to be a stranger as he did not converse with anyone else and did not appear to be known at the bar. BOWER stated that he had never seen the subject before and that he would take him to be of Latin American descent, that he talked fairly good English but with a Mexican accent.
