ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO SIXTYTHREE, DALLAS, TEXAS.

CORNELIUS LENNON ONE ZERO EIGHT SPRUCE STREET, WATERTOWN, MASS.

ADVISES WAS ON FLIGHT NUMBER TWENTY BRANIFF AIRLINES FROM HOUSTON ON ELEVEN TWENTY-ONE SIXTYTHREE. A MALE INDIVIDUAL WHO BOARDED FLIGHT AT HOUSTON AND DEPARTED AT DALLAS, OCCUPYING SEAT FIFTEEN-C INDICATED HIS DISPLEASURE WITH PRESIDENT. COMMENTED THAT HE WAS NOT LIKED AND THEY WERE CONCERNED ABOUT PRESIDENT-S WELFARE DURING VISIT TO TEXAS. SAID IT WAS OBVIOUS THERE WAS CONCERN AS VICE-PRESIDENT WAS COMING TO TEXAS ON A SEPARATE FLIGHT. OCCUPANT OF SEAT FIFTEEN-C DESCRIBED AS WHITE- MALE - FIFTYFIVE TO SIXTY YEARS OF AGE, FIVE FEET TEN INCHES - ONE HUNDRED SIXTY POUNDS- GREY HAIR. THIS INDIVIDUAL DID NOT MAKE ANY SPECIFIC THREATS BUT SIMPLY INDICATED HIS DISLIKE FOR PRESIDENT.

HOUSTON AT BRANIFF AIRLINES IDENTIFY OCCUPANT OF SEAT FIFTEEN-C ON FLIGHT TWENTY THURSDAY ELEVEN TWENTY-ONE SIXTYTHREE. CHECK INDICES ASCERTAIN BACKGROUND AND CONDUCT ANY INVESTIGATION DEEMED LOGICAL.
