*Be* ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER  
TWENTY TWO, NINETEEN SIXTY THREE, DALLAS, TEXAS. RE LOS ANGELES  
TELETYPE NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO LAST.

IN AN EFFORT TO FURTHER CLARIFY TELEPHONE CONVERSATION  
ATTRIBUTED TO <sup>CALIF.</sup> JANET DEANE, MISS EDWINA WILLIAMS, ONE SIX  
SIX FOUR FIVE BOSQUE, ENCINO, CALIFORNIA, WAS CONTACTED  
THIS DATE. WILLIAMS IS A FRIEND OF DEANE AND ADVISED  
THAT DEANE WAS AT HER HOME ON FRIDAY MORNING HAVING SLEPT  
THERE THE PREVIOUS EVENING. SHE ADVISED THAT THEY WERE  
MADE AWARE OF THE ASSASSINATION BY HER SISTER-IN-LAW DANIELLE  
<sup>CALIF.</sup> WILLIAMS, WHO CONTACTED THEM ON THE TELEPHONE. AFTER  
HEARING THE NEWS THEY TURNED ON TELEVISION FOR FURTHER  
CONFIRMATION AND WHILE THE TELEVISION WAS ON DEANE CALLED  
HER UNCLE IN HUNTINGTON BEACH AND HER PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT.

WILLIAMS ADVISED SHE DID NOT PAY PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO DEANE-S TELEPHONE CONVERSATION AS SHE WAS LISTENING TO THE TELEVISION. SHE STATED THAT SHE COULD NOT RECALL DEANE MAKING ANY STATEMENT IN HER PRESENCE THAT SHE HAD HEARD WITHIN THE LAST FEW DAYS THAT THE PRESIDENT WAS TO BE SHOT IN TEXAS ON FRIDAY. THERE APPEARS TO BE NO BEARING ON ASSASSINATION AND NO FURTHER ACTION BEING TAKEN.

SECRET SERVICE BEING ADVISED LOCALLY.
