GOODS, TWO TWO SEVEN WASHINGTON ST., CHICAGO, ILL. STATES
PRICE OF WEAPON WITH A FOUR POWER SCOPE IS TWENTY DOLLARS
AND WITHOUT SCOPE IS PRICED AT FOURTEEN DOLLARS, AND THAT
IT CAN BE ORDERED BY MAIL.

ALSO, THIS DATE, ANONYMOUS CALL RECEIVED THAT HOWARD
HARVEY, CANADIAN CITIZEN, EMPLOYED AT WALTHAM GRINDING WHEEL,
WALTHAM, MASS., UPON HEARING OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY-S DEATH
NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO LAST, REMARKED QUOTE THE SHOOTING OF
KENNEDY WAS THE BEST THING THAT CAME OUT OF TEXAS IN THE
LAST HUNDRED YEARS. UNQUOTE. SOURCE FURTHER ADVISED STATE-
