ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT . . .  
JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63,  
DALLAS, TEXAS

RE: Unknown Man and Woman in Dallas

On November 26, 1963, Morris Rosenthal, 74 Gerald Avenue, Brockton, Massachusetts and his wife, Marie, a school-teacher in West Bridgewater, Massachusetts, advised that her son by a previous marriage, John E. Sullivan, Jr., had worked in Germany in the summer of 1963.

While en route home in September, 1963, he met a man and woman in Glasgow, Scotland who said they were from Texas. When they heard he was from Boston, Massachusetts area, they remarked he was from Kennedy country and that Kennedy had better not come to Texas as they would put a bullet into him.

John F. Sullivan, Jr., a senior at Providence College, Providence, Rhode Island, stated on November 26, 1963 that he rooms at the home of Mrs. Michael J. Mc Guire, 106 Eaton Street, Providence, Rhode Island. He said he had worked in Germany in the summer of 1963 because he had obtained a job as a bartender in the American Student Information Service. He related that while returning home on Friday, September 13, 1963 and when he was in Glasgow, Scotland, he met in a casual fashion an American couple who described themselves as man and wife from Texas. When he mentioned that he was from the Boston, Massachusetts area, they talked about President Kennedy and stated that someone ought to shoot him. He said when they made this remark, they were laughing and Mr. Sullivan stated he believed they had made the remark in jest and did not mean it. He stated that his conversation with these people lasted no more than two or three minutes. At no time was he introduced to them and he did not know either of their last names.
