BA FILES INDICATE JULY TWENTYFOUR LAST MSP REPORTED  
CPL WALTER HOLOWCHAK WHILE OFF DUTY TALKED TO MAN IN LAUREL,  
MD., FILLING STATION WHO SAID HE WAS ENROUTE TO WASHINGTON FROM  
SOUTH CAROLINA TO BLOW PRESIDENT/S HEAD OFF BECAUSE PRESIDENT  
GAVE JOBS TO NEGROES AND HE DID NOT HAVE ONE.

MSP LOCATED THIS INDIVIDUAL SAME DATE ON ROUTE ONE,  
LAUREL, AND HE IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS JAMES HAWKINS, WHITE, MALE,  
BORN AUGUST, NINETEEN FORTYONE, FIVE FEET ELEVEN INCHES, ONE  
FIFTY TO ONE SIXTY POUNDS, SLENDER, SANDY HAIR, RESIDENCE  
RICHMOND, VA., NO STREET ADDRESS, OCCUPATION CARNIVAL WORKER.  
HAWKINS WAS UNARMED, CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN QUOTE JUST TALKING  
UNQUOTE BUT ADMITTED BEING QUOTE ANTI-KENNEDY UNQUOTE. HAWKINS  
NOT HELD BY MSP.
