November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas

INFORMANT

On November 22, 1963, Mr. Craig Work of Old Littleton Road, Harvard, Massachusetts, advised he was formerly employed with a Montgomery Groves, who resided on Nisqually Drive, Sunnyvale, California, and who was working for Lockheed on missile production, approximately four years ago. According to Mr. Work, Groves made the statement that he would gladly shoot the President for a price. Mr. Work stated he does not know if Groves is currently in California, but when he learned of the assassination of the President he immediately recalled this statement by Groves.

On November 22, 1963, the San Francisco Division of the FBI advised that Mr. Richard H. Nelson, Personnel Department, Lockheed Missile Company, Sunnyvale, California, advised Montgomery Bralley Groves, 791 Nisqually Drive, Sunnyvale, California, was employed at this company on June 15, 1961, as an Operations Research Analyst, with date of birth August 18, 1928, at Wichita Falls, Texas. Groves is a former Captain in the United States Army. Mr. Nelson verified that Groves had reported for work on November 22, 1963, and was in the plant at Sunnyvale, California, about 1:00 p.m., November 22, 1963.
