ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, DALLAS, TEXAS, NOVEMBER TWO TWO, NINETEEN SIXTY THREE. AFO.

OFFICER R. K. HERTIG, BUSINESS OFFICE, SDPD, ADVISED AT NINE THIRTY TWO A.M., THIS DATE, THAT BETWEEN NINE AND NINE TWENTY A.M., THIS DATE, HE RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM AN UNKNOWN HYSTERICAL WOMAN WHO TOLD THE SDPD TO CALL PRESIDENT JOHNSON AND TELL HIM THAT HE HAD BETTER NOT ATTEND THE LATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S FUNERAL TOMORROW. WOMAN REFUSED TO GIVE HER NAME OR ANY OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMATION AND HUNG UP.

HERTIG BELIEVED CALL CAME FROM PAY STATION. A CHECK WAS MADE WITH TELEPHONE COMPANY FOR ANY EMERGENCY CALLS TO SDPD DURING PERTINANT PERIOD WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.
