Reference is made to Rosen to Belmont memorandum dated November 22, 1963, captioned as above. Pursuant to Bureau request, SA Henry Rowse, Atlanta Office, telephonically advised at 6:15 PM as follows.

He had recontacted Departmental Attorney A. Frank Grimsley Jr., and he advised that when he first contacted the switchboard operator, Miss Murphy, she was upset. Grimsley subsequently re-interviewed Miss Murphy at which time she advised that the caller rather incoherently stated to the effect, we have you now or we will get you now. The call was made at 3:00 PM, EST. It was made on the U.S. Attorney Office phone and Miss Murphy stated that the person was ranting and raving about the death of the President and said something to the effect we have you now or we will get you now. There was no indication whatsoever that the call was anything but local. Rowse advised that SA Earl Moore, Secret Service and Captain R. E. Rittle, Atlanta, Police Department were advised of this call.
