ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

EVELIO LEY, SECRETARY IN DIRECTORIO REVOLUCIONARIO ESTUDIANTIL / D. R. E. STUDENT REVOLUTIONARY DIRECTRATE/. AN ANTI CASTRO ORGANIZATION AT MIAMI. ADVISED THIS DATE THAT LEE H. OSWALD IN AUGUST NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, AT NEW ORLEANS, LA. APPLIED FOR JOB ON MILITARY INSTRUCTOR IN DRE BASED ON FORMER U.S. MARINE EXPERIENCE. CARLOS BRINGUIER, DRE DELAGATE AT NEW ORLEANS, DISCOVERED OSWALD HAD PREVIOUS ASSOCIATION WITH FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE AND OSWALD WAS REJECTED BY DRE. OSWALD REPORTEDLY SPEAKS SPANISH PERFECTLY AND POSSIBLE RUSSIAN. AFTER OSWALD-S EXPOSURE AS A PRO FIDEL CASTRO HE ENGAGED IN DEBATE WITH BRIGUIER ON NEW ORLEANS RADIO STATION WDSU DURING AUGUST NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE. THE DEBATE WAS FOLLOWED BY A FIGHT FOR WHICH OSWALD WAS ADJUDGED GUILTY IN LOCAL COURT, NEW ORLEANS, AND FINED TWENTY DOLLARS. IN AS MUCH AS OSWALD IS CONSIDERED SUSPECT IN ASSASSINATION NEW ORLEANS LOCATE AND INTERVIEW CARLOS BRINGUIER, WHOSE WHEREABOUTS IS KNOWN BY NEW ORLEANS, FOR DETAILS OSWALD-S ACTIVITIES AND AFFILIATIONS.
