Mr. William Foley, First Assistant, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, advised this afternoon that Assistant Attorney General Miller's office had received a telephone call from Walter Moeller, former Congressman from Ohio. Mr. Moeller advised that while traveling from Washington to Boston over the weekend he overheard a conversation concerning the assassination of President Kennedy, which he thought was most interesting and worthy of being passed along. He requested that he be interviewed concerning this conversation. According to Mr. Foley, Mr. Moeller has an office in the Universal Building, Washington, D. C.

ACTION:

Mr. Foley was advised that this information will be immediately forwarded to the Washington Field Office in order that an Agent could interview former Congressman Moeller this afternoon. Supervisor Grant Nanna, Washington Field Office, was furnished the above information and requested to have an Agent talk to Mr. Moeller this afternoon and advise the Bureau of the results.
