On Movember 25, 1963, Robert and Philipina Codd, 75
6353 Mission Boulevard, Riverside, California, furnished the following information to a Special Agent of the FRI:

At approximately 11:00 p.m., on Movember 24, 1963. two men entered the coffee shop at the Rubidoux, 5645 Mission Boulevard, Riverside, California. After consuming some food Movember 24, 1963. Barbara Albrecht, a waitress at this coffee shop, found a note on their table states. and beverages, they left shortly before midnight on shop, found a note on their table stating words to the effect that Johnson should beware Black Monday. Albrecht retained the note.

On Movember 25, 1963, Barbara Albrecht, 4095 Rees Street, Riverside, California, furnished the following

information to Special Agents of the FBI:

On November 24, 1963, at approximately 11:00 p.m.,
an individual of Mexican appearance entered the coffee shop of
the Rubidoux Bowl, Riverside, California, and sat down at a table. A few minutes later he was joined by a Latin appearing individual. Both of these men ordered ple and coffee, which was served by Barbara Albrecht. They consumed the pie and coffee and carried on a general conversation during the period 11:00 p.m. to approximately 11:30 p.m., when they left the coffee shop. After the men left, Barbara Albrecht recovered a paper napkin with the following written and printed on it:

Johnson it has been decred by special authority that Monday shall go down in history as Black Honday! Thus beware of the wrath of the Black Honday.

Barbara Albrecht noticed that the Latin appearing man prepared the note.

Barbara Albrecht described the individuals as

Mexican appearing male: 21 - 22 120 pounds Dark Weights "Complexions" Dark Hairs t None Weatly dressed in slacks and a mester

Latin appearing male:
Complexion:
Hair: Dark Black Brown, wore glasses 5' 8" - 5' 10" Neatly dressed in slacks and Dress: a sveater

Neither Barbara Albrecht nor Philipina Codd, who also is employed at the coffee shop, Rubidoux Bowl, could recall having ever seen the two individuals before. They could furnish no additional information concerning their

Identity.
Fred Maurer, a dishwasher, and Don Atwood, a bartender at the Rubidoux, were also interviewed and could Armish no information as to the identity of these persons.
