US ARMY ENLISTED MAN BY NAME OF QUIROGA, NOT FUTWER IDENTIFIED,
 REPORTEDLY MADE STATEMENT ABOUT FIVE THIRTY PM ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO
 LAST IN EL PASO THAT HE HAD BEEN IN DALLAS PREVIOUS EVENING AND
 KNEW THAT THE ASSASSINATION WAS GOING TO TAKE PLACE. INVESTIGATION
 AT FORT ELISS, TEXAS, FAILED TO IDENTIFY QUIROGA, WHICH IS AN UNCOM-
 MON LAST NAME. WASHINGTON FIELD REQUESTED TO CHECK RECORDS OF
 DEPARTMENT OF ARMY FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS WITH LAST NAME QUIROGA
 STATIONED FORT BLISS AND EL PASO AREA IN ORDER THAT EFFORTS MAY BE MADE
 BY EL PASO OFFICE TO IDENTIFY QUIROGA IN QUESTION. 62-109060-89
