US ARMY ENLISTED MAN BY NAME OF QUIROGA, NOT FUTHER IDENTIFIED,
REPORTEDLY MADE STATEMENT ABOUT FIVE THIRTY PM ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO
LAST IN EL PASO THAT HE HAD BEEN IN DALLAS PREVIOUS EVENING AND
KNEW THAT THE ASSASSINATION WAS GOING TO TAKE PLACE. INVESTIGATION
AT FORT ELISS, TEXAS, FAILED TO IDENTIFY QUIROGA, WHICH IS AN UNCOMMON LAST NAME. WASHINGTON FIELD REQUESTED TO CHECK RECORDS OF
DEPARTMENT OF ARMY FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS WITH LAST NAME QUIROGA
