F. KENNEDY, DALLAS, TEXAS, NOV. TWENTYTWO, LAST, AFO.

MR. AND MRS. RICHARD V. LE CLAIR, JACKSONPORT, WIS.,
ADDRESS ROUTE TWO, STURGEON BAY, WIS. ON THIS DATE ADVISED THEY
WERE IN DALLAS, TEXAS NOV. TWENTYTWO, LAST, AND AT APPROXIMATELY
ELEVEN AM WERE AT THE NOAH CAMP AND SONS AMBULANCE SERVICE AND
FUNERAL HOME AT FOUR TWO ZERO TWO LIVE OAK, WHEN AN EMPLOYEE OF
THE FUNERAL HOME CAME IN THE BACK DOOR CARRYING WHAT APPEARED
TO BE A SHORT RIFLE WITH TELESCOPIC SIGHT. MR. RICHARD LE CLAIR
THOUGH WITH WIFE AT THIS TIME DID NOT SEE THE EMPLOYEE CARRYING
THE GUN. MRS. LE CLAIR ADVISED SHE SAW THIS EMPLOYEE ENTER THE
BACK DOOR, CARRY THE GUN IN HIS RIGHT HAND AT HIS SIDE, THAT
GUN HAD OVERALL LENGTH OF APPROXIMATELY THREE FEET, SHORT
TELESCOPIC SIGHT OF ABOUT SIX TO EIGHT IN. IN LENGTH, ENTIRE
GUN AND SIGHT BEING DARK COLOR. BOTH DESCRIBED THIS EMPLOYEE

AS NAME UNKNOWN, WHITE, SIX FEET, TWO HUNDRED LBS., LIGHT BROWN HAIR, SHORT CUT. WIFE STATES THIS EMPLOYEE APPROXIMATELY IN EARLY THIRTY-S. HUSBAND STATES THIS EMPLOYEE IN EARLY TWENTY-S AND NOT OVER TWENTYTWO. BOTH CERTAIN AS TO FACT OF EMPLOYMENT THIS MAN BY FUNERAL HOME AS THEY WERE IN DALLAS AT TAYLOR CLINIC WHERE THEIR EIGHT YEAR OLD SON HAD JUST DIED NIGHT OF NOV. TWENTYONE, LAST, AND HAD JUST THAT MORNING BEEN DELIVERED FROM THE STONELEIGH /PH/ HOTEL TO THE FUNERAL HOME BY THIS EMPLOYEE AT APPROXIMATELY TEN AM, NOV. TWENTYTWO, LAST. BOTH LE CLAIRS ADVISE THEY WERE EXTREMELY SHAKEN BY SUDDEN AND UNEXPECTED DEATH OF THEIR SON FROM LEUKEMIA AT TIME OF INCIDENT AND DID NOT REPORT PRIOR TO THIS TIME DUE TO THEIR EMOTIONAL STATE AND DUE TO FACT THEY DID NOT KNOW POSSIBLE SIGNIFICANCE OF WHAT THEY SAW UNTIL LATER AND DID NOT DESIRE TO BECOME INVOLVED OR DELAY HANDLING OF SON-S BODY.
