SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN F. KENNEDY

At 8:53 a.m., 12/1/68, Quentin Fare, Panther, West Virginia, telephonically contacted Midnight Supervisor William E. Adams regarding the captioned matter.

Fare is a visual, intoxicated and in a argumentative mood. He stated that, as a marksman, he knew it was impossible to fire three shots from a bolt-action rifle in five seconds, and wanted to know that the FBI's investigation had proved. He was informed that details of the FBI's investigation could not be released as such information was confidential.

The telephone conversation was terminated when another call was received by Supervisor Adams.
